Many organisations will include some "behavioral services" without offering anything like a full-time behavioural intervention (ABA) program or one overseen by a board certified behavior analyst.

Before you sign up for anything, whether it's with a centre, a school, or an independent consultant, be sure to check the service provider's qualifications- internationally the most well established and regarded are those 'board certified' by the BACB. Also as much as possible, talk to other families and seek references.
